1. Promote CTA: Prepared Information Packet, Business Cards, and Tri-Fold Brochures..
2. Through coordination with the City P&R, the 3 Portola courts were resurfaced
3. **Web Site:** Improved, updated, and now maintain by **Main Street**.
4. Parks and Rec Advisory Board: Presentation made regarding the future (TSC) Indoor Tennis & Sports Complex - Site visit to land and buildings on Lower River Road.
5. **Grant Writers:** Hired Grant Writers Walt and Pam Slater and obtained several grants including a **USTA** Technology Grant for our Computer and Software
6. **USTA** CTA Workshop in Atlanta Georgia: Learned more about running a CTA. We will also attend the CTA Workshop in February 2008 at Las Vegas NV
7. **Hi-Tech Championship Backboard.** Raised \$2950.00 in funds to purchase and install the backboard, including a grant of \$1000.00 from Grants Pass Rotary.
8. **USTA Tennis Block Party:** First Annual with 130 participants including over 50 children.
9. **Street Banner:** Designed and installed Banner across 7th street for our Tournament. It will be installed prior to each tournament for 2008 to advertise the GPCTA.
10. **USTA SANCTIONED** Junior Tournament in August 2007. First ever.
11. **Blower, Water Wands, and Squeegees:** Purchased quality equipment for court cleaning.
12. **Power Washer and Generator:** Raised \$1200.00 in funds to purchase equipment for scrubbing of grime and dirt from the courts. In early 2008 all courts will be cleaned.
13. **“Outstanding Contribution to the Community Award”** - for 2007 from **USTA**.
14. **“CTA of the Year Award“** for 2007 from **Racquet Sports Industry Magazine**.
15. **Monday and Wednesday Night Progressive Doubles:** Expanded and improved.
